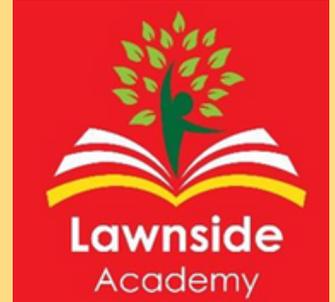

PE day is Tuesday, please ensure that your child is dressed in PE kit for the day. -Mrs Blackford and Mrs Dawson

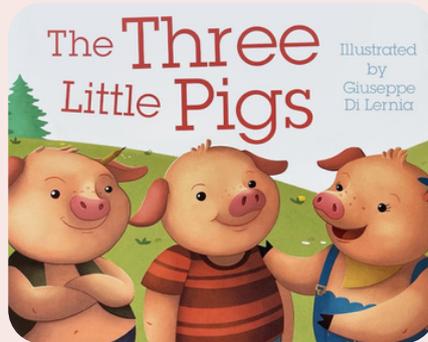
Show and Tell
