Equipment needed inside the pencil case:

We will provide handwriting pens for all the children.

Please ensure that your child is in the correct school uniform in September, which includes appropriate school footwear and a white or red plain polo shirt (no football shirts or t-shirts with logos) with grey or black skirt/shorts/trousers.

For PE, children need to be wearing appropriate trainers, plain white or red t-shirts (no football shirts or t-shirts with logos) and black shorts/joggers. Long hair also needs to be tied up and earrings need to be removed before school or covered.

Please may we ask that no toys or fidget toys are brought into school.

If you would like to support your child over the summer holidays so that they are Year 5 & 6 ready - they need to know all their timetables and relevant division facts up to 12x12. Also, for our year 5's they need to be able to read and write all of the Year 3 & 4 common exception words and for our Year 6's they need to continue learning the Year 5 & 6 common exception words.
