We have made it!

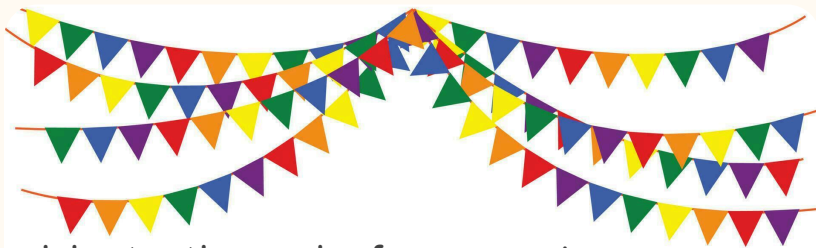
It is the end of your child's Reception year, and what a fantastic year it has been. It has been a pleasure to watch the children grow, flourish and develop throughout the year.
